

## THE KRUMBLE FOUNDATION INTERNSHIP STIPEND PROGRAM

The Krumble Foundation Internship Stipend Program is designed to encourage and support outstanding students who are interested in pursuing an unpaid internship at non-profit or governmental agency. Students can apply for an stipend of up to \$3000 to help alleviate any financial barriers that's preventing them from pursuing an internship (flight cost, housing cost, etc). To apply for the stipend, students must meet the following criteria:

- •Be a full-time student
- •Be a junior or senior or in credit standing, or a graduate student
- •Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
- •Have an internship in a non-profit or governmental agency
- •Must be an unpaid internship
- •Be receiving academic credit for your internship
- •Work with the faculty internship advisor within your major

#### How to get started:

Work with the EWU Internship Coordinator at the Career Center for assistance on how to find an internship. Once you are in the process of securing an internship, complete the application for the Krumble Foundation Internship Stipend. You can find the application by going to <u>inside.ewu.edu/careercenter/</u>, picking up a physical copy at the Career Center in PUB 332, or email the internship coordinator directly (see below).

In order to apply for the stipend, the following materials must be submitted to us by **Friday**, **March 1**, **2024** by **5:00pm**. Application review and final recipient selection will be conducted by the Career Center, and the recipients will be contacted by **Friday**, **March 29**, **2024**. Students must turn in the following documents to be eligible:

- 1. The signed application form (next page).
- 2. Attach your 1-2 page letter of interest (in professional letter format) to the application outlining:
  - Who you are as a student?
  - What your internship is and how does it correlate with your career goals
  - Any extra-curricular activities, community service involvement, or employment, and how this engagement would likely assist in your internship success.
  - Please describe how this stipend will financially impact your internship experience (travel, childcare, job sacrifice, tuition, attire/equipment etc.)
  - This scholarship was created to alleviate any financial barriers that would prevent students from pursuing an internship. If you don't receive this stipend, will it prevent you from pursuing your internship?
