#### A History of Eastern Washington University

In 1882, the Benjamin P. Cheney Academy opened its doors to more than 200 enrolling students. A generous contribution of \$10,000 from a wealthy transportation industrialist had at last fulfilled the dreams of Cheney citizens for an institute of higher learning in their community.

The academy became the State Normal School at Cheney in 1889, the same year in which Washington was given its statehood. The school was proudly designated as an institution "for the purpose of instruction of persons, both male and female, in the art of teaching the various branches that pertain to a good common school."

By the time it became Eastern Washington College of Education in 1937, Eastern was already a fully accredited four-year degree-granting institution, offering majors in numerous subjects.

The campus grew rapidly in size and program offerings in the decades following World War II. In 1961, the name was again changed, this time to Eastern Washington State College. It was increasingly evident that the region needed professionals in many fields; in response, a wide range of undergraduate and graduate degree programs were added. Finally, in 1977, the name was changed to Eastern Washington University by the state legislature.

As a regional university, Eastern is charged with the special responsibility of meeting the undergraduate and graduate educational needs of the region's people.

To that end, program areas have grown and been redefined as the needs of the Inland Northwest have grown and changed. Master's programs have been added to meet the need for graduate-level education, and individual programs and schools have increasingly been granted accreditation by their respective oversight organizations as those programs and schools have grown and matured.

Today, Eastern students represent nearly every state in the union and more than 40 foreign countries. More than 100 different academic majors are available, offering students a wide variety of career-path options.

Nearly 600 full-time and adjunct faculty teach on the Cheney campus and at several locations throughout the state. Three-quarters of Eastern's full-time faculty members hold doctorate degrees. With a low student-to-faculty ratio, Eastern continues to stress small classes, personalized instruction and individual attention.

Perhaps even more significant than Eastern's steady advancement during the past 135 years is the university's expanded regional role and its evolving goals, objectives and vision of its future.

In the past decade, Eastern Washington University has become a major force in the state and the Pacific Northwest, not only in the education of more than 12,000 students each year, but in the civic, cultural, scientific and economic development of the state and region.

# Graduation with Academic Honors

Undergraduate students who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance are honored in the commencement program listing.

Summa Cum Laude: Seniors who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.90-4.00-Gold Honors Cord.

*Magna Cum Laude:* Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.70-3.89-Silver Honors Cord.

*Cum Laude:* Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.50-3.69-Red and White Honors Cord.

*University Honors:* Seniors who completed special course work requirements through the Honors Program-Purple Honors Cord.

#### University Mace

The tradition of a ceremonial mace for academic institutions goes back to medieval times. Adapted in form from the ancient battle weapon used by knights, the ceremonial mace symbolized the authority of regal personages, city or shire ruling bodies and chief officers of chartered institutions.

Originally representing vested authority during all official meetings, it eventually came to be connected mainly with formal ceremonies. In academic institutions, this is usually in conjunction with an academic procession, where the mace is carried at the head of the line of march or just before the platform party.

The form of the ceremonial mace has remained fairly consistent over the centuries. Design often reflects the period of creation, especially in the elaboration of ornamentation. Gold, silver and dark wood are traditional materials.

Eastern's mace, commissioned as a gift during the centennial year to the university by former and present members of the EWU Board of Trustees, was created by artist-craftsman Clifford Gaynard after a region-wide design competition. Its planished silver head in flowing cuplike form carries the university seal. The dark rosewood shaft with upper and medial gold-plated bosses is gently curved into the terminal silver cap at the bottom.

Although the modern design departs from the traditional straight and elaborately ornamented pattern, it retains a full effect of balance, dignity and decorum, while capturing the flowing lines typical of the eastern Washington landscape.

A permanent display case for the Eastern Washington University mace is located in the Office of the President.

#### Academic Regalia

The regalia worn for formal academic ceremonies such as commencements are patterned after the gowns and hoods worn regularly in the Middle Ages by scholars for warmth in unheated buildings and as distinguishing dress denoting their place in society.

A great variety of designs and colors developed over the years in the costumes worn at different universities. Since 1895 in the United States, a uniform intercollegiate code of style and colors has been adhered to by most institutions.

In accordance with this code, most academic gowns are black, although some universities permit other solid colors. Occasionally, the robe color may indicate a professional distinction, such as deep purple for law or scarlet for ecclesiastical honors. Adaptations of the academic costume for high schools have sometimes used colors other than black for purely decorative purposes. Sometimes a distinguishing device on the robe or cap indicates an individual honor or a special occasion.

The baccalaureate gown is of simple cut with full, somewhat pointed sleeves. The front is closed and often no hood is worn with this gown. The mortar board head covering originated in ancient Greece, symbolizing the

commitment of the scholar to a life of building. It has either a plain black tassel or one of a color indicating the subject area of the degree. The custom of shifting the cap's tassel from right to left at the time of awarding the degree is used in lieu of investing each candidate with the bachelor's hood.

The master's gown is similar to the bachelor's gown, except that the sleeves are fuller, cut square with a half-circle at the bottom and sometimes worn with the arms through a horizontal slit at elbow level.

The doctoral robe is ampler in cut with a full bell-shaped sleeve, velvet panel edging in the front and three velvet stripes on each sleeve. The velvet trim may be black or in the color appropriate to the degree. The mortar board tassel for the doctorate is gold. Some American and many foreign universities use cap forms other than the mortar board, ranging from a soft velvet beret to more elaborate fringed styles, each of which has its own historical tradition.

Hoods worn over the gowns have a velvet edging, usually in a color indicating the specific degree and a lining which is partially turned out to show the colors of the college or university which granted the degree.

#### Ken Privratsky

Ken Privratsky spent 33 years in the U.S. Army before retiring in 2002 as a Major General. He graduated from Eastern Washington State College in 1969 as an ROTC distinguished graduate and served as an infantry platoon leader in combat in Vietnam.

Maj. Gen. Privratsky has been awarded the highest service decorations and received personal recognition from the vice president of the United States for his revolutionary changes to military distribution operations.

After leaving the military, he entered the ocean shipping business with the largest domestic shipping company in the U.S. He became responsible for operations spanning the Pacific, including terminal operations in Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, and along the West Coast of the U.S. He retired from industry in 2010.

He has written several articles on military matters over the years. His interest in and research of the Falklands War culminated in British publication of his book *Logistics in the Falklands War* in 2014.

Maj. Gen. Privratsky was an assistant professor at West Point and a National Security Affairs Fellow at the Hoover Institution of War, Revolution and Peace at Stanford University. He has earned master's degrees in English, business and military science.

He is a past chair of Special Olympics Alaska and has served on multiple other boards, including Anchorage Economic Development Corporation, Armed Forces YMCA, Covenant House Alaska and World Trade Center Alaska.

In 2007, Maj. Gen. Privratsky and his wife, alumna Kathy (Iverson) Privratsky, established an endowed scholarship for EWU students pursuing an MS in communication disorders. To date, this scholarship has helped 12 graduate students reach their goal of becoming speech-language pathologists.



#### Jo Ann Kauffman

Jo Ann Kauffman is a member of the Nez Perce Tribe. She served as a member of the EWU board of trustees from 2003 to 2015, including two terms as its chair. She is a nationally recognized leader in the field of Indian health care and community wellness.

For the past 27 years, she has been president and CEO of Kauffman & Associates, Inc., a Spokane-based company that provides management consulting, strategic planning, corporate communications and program evaluation services to agencies of the federal, state and tribal governments, nonprofit organizations and private philanthropies. Her company addresses issues of public health, wellness, community development, justice and education services.

Kauffman received her undergraduate degree from Western Washington University in 1976, and her master's in public health from the University of California at Berkeley in 1979.

She helped start rural health clinics on three Indian reservations in Northern Idaho, and she ran a large health center serving Native Americans in Seattle. The Freedom Forum of the Gannett Foundation awarded her their prestigious "Free Spirit Award" in 1998 in recognition of her persistent advocacy for Native and other vulnerable populations. In 2015, the Spokane YWCA awarded her the Women of Achievement "Carl Maxey, Racial & Social Justice Award."

#### Jo Ann Kauffman

Jo Ann Kauffman is a member of the Nez Perce Tribe. She served as a member of the EWU board of trustees from 2003 to 2015, including two terms as its chair. She is a nationally recognized leader in the field of Indian health care and community wellness.

For the past 27 years, she has been president and CEO of Kauffman & Associates, Inc., a Spokane-based company that provides management consulting, strategic planning, corporate communications and program evaluation services to agencies of the federal, state and tribal governments, nonprofit organizations and private philanthropies. Her company addresses issues of public health, wellness, community development, justice and education services.

Kauffman received her undergraduate degree from Western Washington University in 1976, and her master's in public health from the University of California at Berkeley in 1979.

She helped start rural health clinics on three Indian reservations in Northern Idaho, and she ran a large health center serving Native Americans in Seattle. The Freedom Forum of the Gannett Foundation awarded her their prestigious "Free Spirit Award" in 1998 in recognition of her persistent advocacy for Native and other vulnerable populations. In 2015, the Spokane YWCA awarded her the Women of Achievement "Carl Maxey, Racial & Social Justice Award."

#### Kathy Privratsky

Kathy Privratsky graduated from Eastern Washington State College in 1969 and earned her master's degree in communication disorders in 1973. For 40 years she worked as a speech-language pathologist providing communication and assistive technology services to children.

In 1992, she became assistive technology coordinator for Special Education Service Agency in Anchorage, Alaska, with a focus on services in rural Alaska. During this time, she received the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association's DiCarlo Award for Clinical Excellence. She also received the Governor's Award in 2004 for co-founding Assistive Technology of Alaska and expanding services for all Alaskans. She became its executive director in 2004 and continued until her retirement in 2011.

She has been active in professional forums both nationally and internationally and has conducted dozens of workshops, authored articles and taught college-level courses. She developed a passion for Special Olympics, coordinating Alaska's Healthy Athlete Hearing Program for many years and at the International Winter Games in Alaska in 2001. She also assisted International Games in Japan in 2005 and China in 2009.

#### Ken Privratsky

Ken Privratsky spent 33 years in the U.S. Army before retiring in 2002 as a Major General. He graduated from Eastern Washington State College in 1969 as an ROTC distinguished graduate and served as an infantry platoon leader in combat in Vietnam.

Maj. Gen. Privratsky has been awarded the highest service decorations and received personal recognition from the vice president of the United States for his revolutionary changes to military distribution operations.

After leaving the military, he entered the ocean shipping business with the largest domestic shipping company in the U.S. He became responsible for operations spanning the Pacific, including terminal operations in Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, and along the West Coast of the U.S. He retired from industry in 2010.

He has written several articles on military matters over the years. His interest in and research of the Falklands War culminated in British publication of his book *Logistics in the Falklands War* in 2014.

Maj. Gen. Privratsky was an assistant professor at West Point and a National Security Affairs Fellow at the Hoover Institution of War, Revolution and Peace at Stanford University. He has earned master's degrees in English, business and military science.

He is a past chair of Special Olympics Alaska and has served on multiple other boards, including Anchorage Economic Development Corporation, Armed Forces YMCA, Covenant House Alaska and World Trade Center Alaska.

In 2007, Maj. Gen. Privratsky and his wife, alumna Kathy (Iverson) Privratsky, established an endowed scholarship for EWU students pursuing an MS in communication disorders. To date, this scholarship has helped 12 graduate students reach their goal of becoming speech-language pathologists.

#### Prakash H Bhuta



Prakash Bhuta, PhD, joined the Department of Biology at Eastern Washington University in 1983. Prior to coming to EWU, Bhuta conducted research at the University of Michigan School of Medicine and at the Michigan Cancer Foundation. He received his PhD in microbiology from the University of Southwestern Louisiana and degrees in

pharmacy and microbiology/chemistry from Bombay University.

Bhuta was awarded numerous times for his teaching throughout his 33 years at EWU; he always went the extra mile for his students. Given the nature of many of the lab classes he taught, student experiments often went beyond the time constrains of the lab period, but Bhuta was always there to work with his students.

Like the microorganisms he introduced thousands of students to, Bhuta was adaptable and capable of moving into unoccupied niches. Over the years he steadily contributed to curriculum development, adding new perspectives to existing courses and developing new courses when needed. He was a leader in incorporating new digital and molecular technology into instruction and research. He was instrumental in helping the Biology Department address one of its strategic goals to incorporate molecular biology across the curriculum. Through his conscientious caring, Bhuta mentored hundreds of undergraduate students as their faculty advisor. In a similar vein, he has mentored many new assistant professors in the department.

Bhuta's research has been at the interface between humans, microbes and the environment. He and his graduate students have addressed questions ranging from antibiotic resistant bacteria to the bacterial diversity in natural ecosystems.

Bhuta was equally committed to service. He served as chair of the Department of Biology from 1997-2001. He contributed to EWU's university library system, IT instruction, and to the Spokane community through his work with NPR and other organizations. Everyone who has ever worked with Bhuta will attest to his principled adherence to the universal truths of justice and respect for all people.

#### Diane Dowd



Diane Dowd, PhD, joined the Eastern Washington University faculty in 1995. She remained a genuinely collaborative and supportive colleague, and a generous member of the Department of Mathematics for 20 years.

Dowd brought diverse experiences as a K-12 mathematics teacher and administrator to her expertise

as a mathematics teacher educator preparing elementary and middle school teachers.

Her work outside the department expanded, leading to several grants that impacted mathematics education of K-12 students in rural and urban schools throughout the region. Well-known and respected in eastern Washington by K-12 administrators, counselors and teachers, she was invited across the state for her expertise. This led her to be sought after as a consultant in districts, which she remained active in throughout her career.

Her work at EWU included publishing articles with faculty from the education, music and business departments.

During her tenure, she performed essential service to the department, college and university to improve assessment, curriculum and collaboration among departments. She was frequently a liaison between K-12 schools and EWU students, finding tutors for schools and experience for students.

Her reach expanded across the state as an active member in Washington Teachers of Mathematics and the Washington State Math Council. In this capacity, she provided support for hundreds of children participating in the Math Olympiad and many other events. Dowd will be greatly missed by her colleagues.

#### Meryl Roth Gersh



Meryl Roth Gersh, PT, PhD, has taught in the Department of Physical Therapy at Eastern Washington University since the development of the bachelor's program in 1985. She earned the rank of professor in 1996. Gersh received her BS in physical therapy from the State University of New York at Buffalo in 1974,

her master of medical science from Emory University in 1978, and her PhD in leadership studies from Gonzaga University in 2008. She has served in many capacities at Eastern, including chair of the department, on multiple committees across the university, as chair of the Graduate Affairs Council, and on the Academic Programs Assessment Committee. Gersh served as vice president of the Academy of Clinical Electrophysiology and Wound Management of the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA), and on the board of directors for the Physical Therapy Association of Washington.

She has spoken extensively and provides clinical consultation on the topics of electrophysiology, electrotherapy and pain management, and is the author of numerous articles on these subjects, as well as the editor of the text, *Electrotherapy in Rehabilitation*, published by F.A. Davis Company.

Gersh has received recognition for her professional and academic service, including the Distinguished Service Award and Physical Therapist of the Year award from the Physical Therapy Association of Washington, Award for Excellence from the Academy of Clinical Electrophysiology and Wound Management, the Lucy Blair Service Award from the APTA, the Leadership in Education Award from the APTA, and the Trustees' Medal from Eastern Washington University.

#### Laura S. Hodgman

Laura Hodgman, PhD, earned her doctorate degree in 1993, and MA in history in 1987, from the University of Illinois-Urbana. In 1984, she earned her BA in history from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

At EWU, Hodgman has taught Russian, European, comparative social and oral history, as well as courses in historical methods. Her scholarly publications range from *Bolsheviks and the Bottle*, a monograph on working-class drinking in revolutionary Russia, to an article on the 1977 murder of a transgender woman in Tacoma.

Hodgman served in several leadership roles and on numerous committees in EWU's Department of History, including the Graduate Committee, Undergraduate Committee (2005-08) and Chair, Undergraduate Committee (2008-14), Social Studies Education Committee (2007-14) and as history undergraduate advisor (2006-14). She served as History Department chair (2001-02). In addition, she served as an EWU Pride Center volunteer (2011-13) and on the EWU Faculty Organization's Academic Computing Council (2003-11).

She has received numerous fellowships, grants and awards, including the Northwest Institute for Advanced Study Mini Grants, National Endowment for the Humanities Grant to participate in the Summer Research Institute, "Visual Resources for Teaching and Research in Early East Slavic Cultures," New York Public Library (2006), International Research and Exchanges Board Advance Research Grant and the Kennan Institute for Advance Russian Studies Research Fellowship.

Hodgman has also been active in the community as a volunteer for OutSpokane (2013, 2014), Volunteers of America (2011) and as a volunteer/consultant for Neighborhoods Matter (2013). She is a member of the Oral History Association.

#### Sarah A. C. Keller



Sarah Keller, PhD, arrived at Eastern in fall 1966 from her home in Boston planning to "see the West," and earn some money while finishing her dissertation. She received her PhD from Harvard University in 1971, but by then had become a North Westerner and stayed. In the 51 years she has been at Eastern she has taught an estimated

7,000-plus students, sent many on to professional careers, and founded the program and built the staff. Although she initially taught "everything," she focused on physical anthropology courses, and latterly food and nutrition topics.

Keller has served on numerous university committees and boards and was department chair 1997-2005, and anthropology program director much of the time. She received the EWU Trustees Medal in 2009, and the Dean's Excellence Award for service to the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences in 2008. She was Faculty Fellow for Research in 2006, and a faculty representative to Zheng Zhou University, China, in spring 2001. She chaired or cochaired the Northwest Anthropology Conference five times from the 1980s and as recently as spring 2017.

Her field work has been in North America, Guatemala, England, France and China. Additional professional work has been forensic analysis in eastern Washington and North Idaho, NAGPRA repatriation, and 12 years on the Spokane City/County Landmarks Commission.

In retirement, she looks forward to travel on land and sea (but not air), summers in Nova Scotia, a bit of adjunct teaching, continuing as a USFSA (Figure Skating) judge and food-related charities.

#### Martha Raske



Martha Raske, MSW and PhD, joined the EWU faculty in 2011 as professor and chair/director of the School of Social Work. After completing her BA at MacMurray College in Jacksonville, Illinois, she went on to earn the MS in rehabilitation counseling at Illinois Institute of Technology and MSW

and PhD from the Jane Addams College of Social Work in Chicago.

Prior to beginning her academic career, Raske worked as a rehabilitation counselor, social worker and program administrator in the fields of disability, mental health, crisis management and education.

In addition to co-authoring and editing the text, *Ending disability discrimination: Strategies for social workers*, her research focused attention on the client perspective of social workers and social welfare services, including persons diagnosed with serious mental illness, persons with disabilities and elders living in nursing homes. Raske spent the past 23 years as a teacher and eventually leader in social work education. Her research also drew attention to the student perspective of higher education. She taught across the social work curriculum, including research methods, social welfare policy analysis, human behavior in the social environment and advanced mental health practice.

She served as MSW program director and social work department chair prior to coming to EWU as chair/director of the School of Social Work. During her career she served on numerous social welfare agency boards and advisory groups.

#### Randel Wagner



Randel Wagner, PhD, is retiring from his position as director of vocal studies at Eastern Washington University, where he has been teaching full time since 1998. He earned his doctorate of music in vocal performance and pedagogy from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and his master's degree in vocal performance

and choral conducting from San Diego State University. He earned his bachelor of music education degree from Walla Walla College.

Wagner taught choral and vocal music at high schools in California and Maryland, as well as at colleges in Texas and Nebraska. Before coming to EWU, he served as voice faculty at Towson University in Baltimore.

Wagner has maintained a rigorous performing and conducting schedule during his career. As a professional baritone, he has performed with the Seattle, Tacoma, Spokane and Coeur d'Alene Opera companies, his favorite role being Marcello in La Bohème. He has performed with the San Francisco Opera, Spokane Symphony Orchestra, Oregon Bach Festival and N.W. Bach Festival. He has presented recitals, clinics and master classes across the U.S., Europe and Asia. In several trips to Japan and Taiwan, he performed with the Mukogawa Women's University, the Mukagowa 100-voice choir and the Teleman Orchestra. He also performed Haydn's Paukenmesse in London and Paris.

Wagner has conducted the Nebraska Honor Choir, Archdiocese of Seattle Choral Festival at Benaroyal Hall, Festival of the Arts (Spokane), North Idaho Honor Choir Festival and Montana Honor Treble Choir. He has judged the Northwest Regional Metropolitan Opera auditions, Oregon Choir Championships, state choral festivals in Washington, Idaho and Oregon.

#### Gabor Zovanyi



Gabor Zovanyi served as professor of Urban and Regional Planning from 1986 to 2016. He gained recognition as an important scholar in the field of growth management; was an excellent and dedicated teacher throughout his career; and supported community service, service to the university and to our planning profession.

He earned his PhD in urban planning at the University of Washington, MURP from San Diego State University and a BA in economics from UCLA. He was a Fulbright Scholar in Budapest, Hungary, and a cooperative officer of Ghana as a Peace Corps volunteer. Among many publications, Zovanyi published two texts that helped define Growth Management in relation to planning law, the environment and growth management, making assessments that challenged the profession: The No Growth Imperative: Creating Sustainable Communities under Ecological Limits to Growth (2013); and Growth Management for a Sustainable Future: Ecological Sustainability as the New Growth Management Focus for the 21st century (1998, 2001).

Zovanyi received excellent student evaluation scores, while at the same time being known as a strict instructor with high expectations of student performance. His planning law classes remain notorious for high student expectations and work requirements. Zovanyi served as graduate student advisor for most of his time at EWU with excellent results and supported HUD grants to fund minority and underrepresented students during a 10-year period. As senior faculty in a small department, he served many years on the Department Personnel Committee and on the College Personnel Committee, always representing fair and unbiased assessment.

#### Trustees' Medal Award

The Trustees' Medal Award is the university's highest form of recognition for faculty achievement. Each year since 1978, the award has honored teaching excellence, significant contributions to scholarship and research, and accomplishments in the development of academic programs and curriculums. The award consists of a bronze medallion and a \$1,500 cash prize from the EWU Foundation.

#### William C. Williams, PhD

Throughout his almost 40-year career in Department of Psychology at EWU, William Williams has been exemplary in all three areas that the Trustees' Medal recognizes.

An Eastern alumnus, Williams earned his MS and BA in psychology from the university in the mid-1960s. In 1973, he earned his PhD from the University of Utah.

During his tenure, Williams has served as the psychology department chair three times and his contributions during


those periods were immeasurable. He was instrumental in the last remodel of Martin Hall, with incredible insight to the needs of students in the classroom, as well as innovative space to support faculty scholarship and student research. He has personally recruited faculty experts in the department and has been an unwavering mentor and advocate for junior faculty.

Along with numerous grants, Williams was awarded a "Roadmap to Redesign" grant through which he revolutionized the teaching of general psychology by incorporating technology to enhance the learning experiences of the almost 1,000 students who take the course each year. He obtained funding to redesign classrooms and provide state-

of-the-art technology to facilitate student learning, including the use of clickers and Smart Boards. While these are currently trends in academia, Williams was engaged in these efforts more than 10 years ago.

His initial work in general psychology served as a model for the Early Alert System in place today. By examining online module participation, he could predict which students would struggle in the course by the third week of the quarter.

Williams articulated a starting foundation for the department to consider applied doctorates as an option in the future. He facilitated discussion regarding a psychological clinic, which remains a priority for the department.



He was instrumental in the development of the EWU psychology program at Bellevue College on the west side of the state. This is an incredibly successful program, both in terms of student satisfaction and financial sustainability. He paved the way for the program through countless trips to Bellevue to meet with key partners and provided hands-on assistance in conceptualizing the program, documenting viability and formalizing approval. He has served as one of the program's greatest supporters, routinely volunteering to travel to Bellevue College on a weekly basis to offer courses that would otherwise

not be available to students.

As a core faculty member of the Master of Science in Experimental Psychology program, he offers expertise that no one else can. It's no surprise that he has been recognized repeatedly for his excellence in teaching and mentorship.

Williams has also made significant contributions to the field of psychology. He is currently working with the EWU Biology Department to examine the MAOA gene to see if there is a relationship between this and childhood maltreatment and aggression. This groundbreaking research has the potential to make a significant impact on individuals in our society.

Williams has repeatedly published in the field and in reputable, well-circulated

peer-reviewed journals. He's been a great research mentor to students and routinely has one of the largest labs in the department. His students consistently present at local, national and international conferences.

Students have praised the incredible learning opportunities his courses, research opportunities and mentoring have provided and many are going on to master- and doctoral-level programs as a result of his support.

#### DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS

The Distinguished Service Awards are given each year to recognize exemplary service and outstanding contributions to the university. Letters of nomination and support are reviewed by the University Medals and Awards Committee.

The award includes the Distinguished Service Award medallion and a check for \$1,000. These awards were presented at the University Family Thanksgiving reception in November 2016.

Frances B. Huston Medallion Recognizes Graduating Seniors for Excellence in Academics, Leadership, and Service

Frances Breitweg Huston was born in Vancouver, Washington, Aug. 13, 1912. She grew up in Portland, Oregon, and received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Reed College in 1931 and her Master of Arts in English Literature from the University of Washington (1947/1948). In 1955, Graham Dressler, PhD, professor of English at what was then Eastern Washington College of Education, offered Huston a position teaching English and English as a second language. Huston joined EWU's faculty in the fall of 1955 and taught until her retirement in academic year 1975/1976.

The Frances B. Huston Medallion Award was established in 1998 by a gift from Mary Ann Nelson, EWU professor of English emerita, as a tribute to Huston's lifelong commitment to education and a generosity to students that was quiet but ongoing. The medallion award program recognizes outstanding graduates and reflects Huston's compassion and respect for

what education can do for an individual and a community. This award is presented to only 20 graduating students each year. Recipients of the Frances B. Huston Medallion Award will have established themselves as exceptionally capable individuals in both academic and extracurricular activities. The faculty and administration of Eastern Washington University acknowledge their great pride in the accomplishments of these students during their college experience and expect even greater accomplishments in the years that lie ahead.

To be eligible to receive the award, students must

- be graduating seniors;
- have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement with a minimum of a 3.75 GPA in their previous four quarters; and
- qualify for the award in one or more of the following areas: leadership, service to the university and/or service to the community.
