

PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY EWU Spokane Campus Sex Offender Information Bulletin Notification of Release Level II Offender



The Spokane County WA Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender release when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individuals who appear on such notifications have been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office in the county of their residence. Further, their previous criminal history places them in a classification level which reflects the potential to reoffend .This individual has served the sentence imposed on them by the courts. *HE/SHE IS NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.*

Law Enforcement has no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, this offender is constitutionally free to live wherever he/she chooses.

McCuistion has been released on a Less Restriction Alternative from McNeil Island. He still has his Sexually Violent Offender status. His sex crime victim was an adult female. He also had several assault convictions that had underlying sexual components to them but was not convicted of a sex crime. Those victims range from a 5-year-old female to adult female strangers. He will be under Dept of Corrections supervision for 24 months. His CCO is Chad Hettinga.
