Timely Warning 9/21/2015

Eastern Washington University Police Department is investigating a reported sexual assault (fondling) that occurred in the lobby of Morrison Hall in the early morning hours on 9/21/15. The victim was followed to Morrison Hall from the University Recreation Center after the event "Rec-Splosion."

The suspect is a white male, approximately 5'6" tall with blond hair, facial hair and acne on his forehead. He was last seen wearing white jeans and a white t-shirt with green logo on the chest, black and purple baseball hat with a Trident logo on the front, black shoes, a white watch, and black glasses. Suspect identified himself with the first name "Matt."

Members of the campus community are urged to take normal personal safety precautions when walking on campus, such as:

- Walking between buildings very late at night is sometimes unavoidable, so try to walk with a friend
- Make sure your cell phone is easily accessible and fully charged
- Be familiar with where emergency phones are installed on the campus
- Be aware of open buildings where you can use a phone
- Take major, public paths rather than less populated shortcuts
- Avoid dimly lit places and talk to campus services if lights need to be installed in an area
- Avoid putting music headphones in both ears so that you can be more aware of your surroundings, especially if you are walking alone
- Carry a noisemaker (like a whistle) on your keychain
- Pepper spray is allowed on campus
- Carry a small flashlight on your keychain
