

Prior to 1977 the grading system was as follows:

A - Superior

B - Excellent

C - Adequate

D - Less than adequate

F - Failure

X - Incomplete

W - Withdrawn

P - Passing (credit granted but no grade points assigned)

NC - No credit (no credit granted, no grade points assigned)

Y - Deferred grade

Grades formerly assigned but not currently approved are: V, audit (no credit or grade points granted); WF, withdrawal failure (no credit granted but credit hours attempted computed); S, satisfactory (credit granted but no grade points assigned); U, unsatisfactory (no credit or grade points granted); Q, course dropped (no credit or grade points granted).
